is the not-for-profit organization responsible for managing the collection and recycling of scrap tires in BC since 2007. Tire Stewardship BC helps tire producers (retailers) meet their regulatory obligations through its ministry-approved EPR plan.

5.7 MILLION

scrap tires* were collected as part of the tire recycling program in 2025

Since 1991, over 128 million scrap tires* have been collected and processed

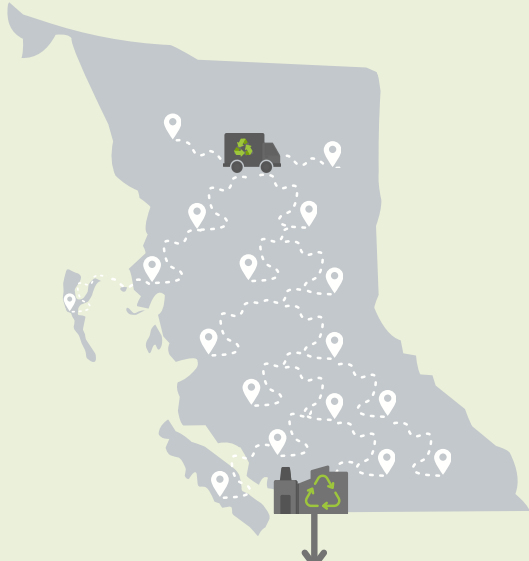
