



## REGISTERING WITH TIRE STEWARDSHIP BC (TSBC)

Established under the BC Society Act, and operating under the British Columbia Societies Act, TSBC is the provincial not-for-profit society responsible for operating BC's scrap tire recycling program in accordance with its BC Ministry of Environment approved Extended Producer Responsibility Plan and the [BC Recycling Regulation](#) (Regulation).

TSBC has the following two registration options:

### 1. Retailer

For the tire program, the Regulation defines a retailer (producer) as a person who:

- *sells, offers for sale or distributes a new tire product in British Columbia;*
- *is the owner or licensee of a trademark under which a tire product is sold or distributed in British Columbia, whether or not the trademark is registered; or,*
- *imports the tire product into British Columbia for sale or distribution.*

For clarity, the term tire product used in the Regulation is defined in TSBC's Schedule A as Program Tires and applies to the sale / distribution of new Program Tires or equipment with new Program Tires. Examples of a retailer include, but is not limited to, the following: tire dealer, wholesaler, distributor, auto service shop, new car dealer, equipment dealer, online tire suppliers, etc.

### 2. Generator

If your business does not sell or offer for sale new Program Tires (including equipment, etc., with new Program Tires on it) but does generate scrap Program Tires available for collection – please register as a **Generator** with TSBC. You can download a copy of the generator registration form [here](#). Examples of a generator include, but is not limited to, the following: landfills, transfer stations, auto wreckers etc.
