### NAME OF SOCIETY

TIRE STEWARDSHIP B.C. ASSOCIATION

### SOCIETY'S PURPOSES

1. to promote and encourage all aspects of recycling of rubber tires in British Columbia;
2. to promote awareness of recycling of pneumatic tires in British Columbia;
3. to represent tire recycling opinion on behalf of the members, including tire brand-owners (as defined in the Post-Consumer Residual Stewardship Program Regulation) before all governmental bodies and agencies having jurisdiction over related matters;
4. to form an industry operated British Columbia tire management board to manage the collection and recycling of scrap tires on a non-profit basis;
5. to conduct promotional, educational, recreational, social and other activities in the furtherance of these purposes;
6. to solicit, accept, receive, acquire, purchase, lease or otherwise, any kind of real and personal property agreement, grant, donation, legacy, gift, bequest or otherwise any kind of real or personal property;
7. to enter into and carry out agreements, undertakings and conditions in connection with the activities mentioned paragraph 5 above;
8. to acquire, hold, purchase, convert, lease, mortgage, sell, or dispose of any asset owned by the Society; and to invest and reinvest any principal in such manner as may from time to time be determined to disburse and distribute monies and property in the furtherance of the purposes set out above.

This society is a member-funded society. It is funded primarily by its members to carry on activities for the benefit of its members. On its liquidation or dissolution, this society may distribute its money and other property to its members.
