


The cycle of responsibility



The Role of the Retailer

You are the obligated party under the Recycling Regulation and TSBC acts as the agency to help you fulfil those obligations under a Ministry of Environment approved Stewardship Plan.

You are registered with TSBC with a 5 digit number.*

You remit an Advance Disposal Fee to TSBC monthly for every program tire you sell in BC or into BC.

You call 1.866.497.0281 when you need scrap tire collection.

You generate scrap tires and make these available for collection by a TSBC hauler and you are aware of the rules for pick up.

You take back the scrap tires from the customer when they buy new tires.

You may also have signed up as a Return to Retailer which means you have agreed to accept up to 4 car tires, clean and off rim from the public.

The Role of the Scrap Tire Generator

You are a company or organization that generates scrap tires but does not sell new tires – examples are landfills, auto-wreckers.

You are registered with TSBC with a 4 digit number.

You require scrap tire pick up and you are aware of the rules for collection.

You are represented on TSBC's advisory committee.

The Role of the Hauler

You are a business that has an agreement with a TSBC registered processor to accept your tires.

You collect scrap tires from TSBC registered retailers and generators.

You record this information on a waste manifest that is submitted to the processor when the scrap tires are delivered to the processor site.

You receive payment from the TSBC program to haul tires.

You have the right to cull tires but you do not get paid by TSBC for those tires.

You do not charge TSBC registered retailers and generators to collect their tires unless they do not meet the rules.

You are represented on TSBC's advisory committee.

The Role of the Processor

You are a company with a site in BC that accepts tires for processing on site.

You are registered with TSBC and have a written agreement in place with TSBC.

You process paperwork as per program policy and submit to TSBC for payment of transportation and processing incentives.

You are familiar with the program policies that affect your business.

You are represented on TSBC's advisory committee.

The Role of the Manufacturer

You are a company with a site in BC that buys BC recycled rubber and manufacturers at least 1M lbs per year into a manufactured product.

You are registered with TSBC and have a written agreement in place with TSBC.

You process paperwork as per program policy and submit to TSBC for payment for manufacturing incentives.

You are familiar with the program policies that affect your business.

You are represented on TSBC's advisory committee.
