

All Tire Generators

Tire Storage / Tires on Rim

Liberty Tire Recycling requires all tire generators to comply with the following conditions to qualify for pickup:

- All tires must be sorted into the following categories
 - Passenger light truck - off rims.
 - Passenger light truck - on rims.
 - Medium truck - off rims only.
 - Large tires not conforming to the above.
- Tires must be accessible for the pick-up unit to back directly to the tire pile.
- Tires must be clean, free of contamination by gravel or other debris.

Tires on Rim

Tires on rims are not listed on the TSBC Schedule A and are not part of the TSBC program.

Note that this fee does not include transportation. Generators requiring their transporter to pick up mounted PLT for disposal should determine from the pickup transporter what additional transportation fees will be assessed for mounted PLT.

Note that tires on rims are accepted at the discretion of the collector/ processor. The above fees, including transportation, will be reviewed periodically and adjusted accordingly as required by fluctuating commodity prices.

Liberty Tire Recycling will accept tires that have been cut off rims if the following conditions are met: 1) Tire is only cut in one spot and is able to be rolled. 2) There is no remnants of the rim or other debris left or imbedded in the tire.
